

WorldCast Anglers has their headquarters at Orvis Jackson Hole but the base operations are on the South Fork of the Snake River. This stretch of river flows for 66 miles across southeastern Idaho until it runs into the Henry's Fork. Epic hatches, and in particular the gigantic salmonfly hatch, should be on every angler's bucket list. Combine it with tremendous terrestrial fishing for gulping trout...there isn't much more you can ask for in a trip. The South Fork of the Snake River is well-known for big trout and in particular its large population of cutthroats. WorldCast Anglers offer either wade or float daytrips for anglers short on time.

Families sign up for the unique two-day overnight trip to both the South Fork Hilton and the Cottonwood camps. The float runs through high-mountain valleys and rugged canyons past the largest cottonwood forest in the West. You'll find more than 100 different species of birds as well as 21 raptors. Float the river and you'll see an abundance of wildlife, with deer, elk, bobcats, coyotes, otter, beaver, mink, fox, mountain goats, mountain lions and black bears. Non-anglers will enjoy the drift as much as those catching fish.

Jackson Hole is located between the Teton and Snake River mountain ranges, and offers year-round activities. Outdoors activities include horseback riding, swimming, mountain biking, hot-air ballooning, wildlife viewing, astronomy and wildlife tours along with spas and culinary events. Or consider a visit to WorldCast's affiliate the Teton Springs Lodge and Spa. Play golf at the Headwaters Golf Club. Here you'll find an 18-hole championship course, a 9-hole par-3 course and a practice facility. And don't miss a trip to Grand Teton National Park, which features the 13,000-foot-plus horns of the high Tetons. The conifer forests, lakes and sagebrush flats are the home bison, moose, elk, coyotes and pronghorn antelope in addition to the countless raptors.

Possum Creek Retreat in Tennessee offers fly-fishing on the South Holston River, a world-class fishery that's a clear, cool tailwater with between 5,000 to 6,000 fish per mile. The average trout caught on the Holston can range from 10 to 20 inches, but every year wild browns are caught in the 10- to 20-pound range. Near Bluff City, Tennessee, the river boasts some of the largest trout this side of the Mississippi. It regularly yields fish that rival those of Arkansas's White River, New Mexico's San Juan River and Montana's Big Hole River, the lodge tells us. *Après* fishing, the Possum Creek Retreat Conference Center provides many advantages in one distraction-free location, allowing your attendees (or family!) to bond as a team. The Conference Center specializes in executive summits, board meetings, sales conferences, training and more. Families will love the game room, which has a pool table, ping-pong table and

retro gaming machines including pin ball and slots; other fun amenities on the property include a hot tub, group fire pit with surrounding Adirondack chairs and a shooting/skeet range.

When you travel to **The High Lonesome Ranch** to fish, you get two ranches in one. The first ranch is in Debeque, Colorado, a quick drive from Grand Junction. At the main ranch anglers have the opportunity to fish the ranch's 18 spring creek ponds, which are full of brookies, browns, rainbows, and cutthroat and cuttbow trout. After you've sight-fished to your heart's content, head down to their sister property, the historic K-T Ranch in Meeker. You'll have access to about 7 miles of the White River and the three spring creeks on the property. Fishing on the White River is great year-round. Run-off is between mid-May through the end of June. The riffles, runs, pools and pockets offer outstanding fishing. To round out the experience, anglers can add a float on the Roaring Fork or the Colorado.

And there's much more going on at the ranch. The equestrian program is organized around half- and full-day rides throughout miles of trails. There are horses and trails for riders of all abilities and ages. The ranch guides are knowledgeable about local history as well as the regional flora and fauna, and will point out wildlife along the way. Serious riders are welcome to bring along their own horses. Riders stay at the HLR's McKay Fork Cow Camp, and within 20 minutes of completing breakfast you'll be on your way up the valley and behold views that span from the Book Cliff Mountains to the distant LaSalle Mountains near Moab, Utah. Birding has become one of the ranch's most popular and sought-after activities, and members from Audubon have visited the ranch to search for an enormous variety of species.

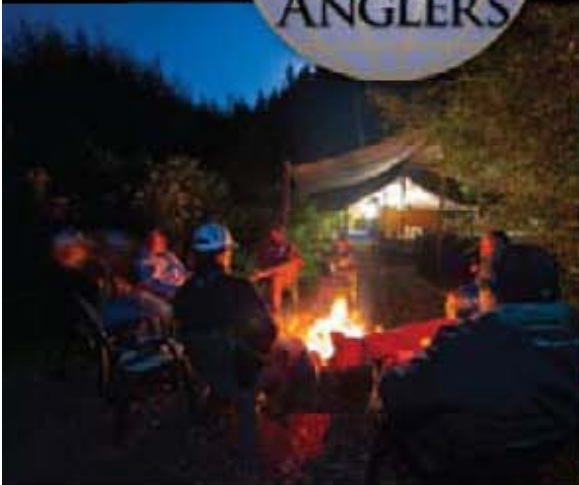
